

What is Curriculum?





What is Curriculum?



- ✓ The word Etymology: curriculum is "a course, especially a
 fixed course of study at a college, university, or school," in
 1824 the word was transferred from classical Latin language
 which had primary word meaning as "running"
- ✓ Educational curriculum is a yearly plan of monthly units, topics by subjects, reading lists, daily activities and lesson plans




Why do you need to plan a Curriculum?



- ✓ You know what/when can you teach your children, do not invent a new bike.
- ✓ Follow the basic subjects of Common Core Standards (CCS) of NYS.
- ✓ Acknowledge the age appropriate activities and subjects.
- ✓ If you plan your monthly unit and subjects you could easily plan daily lessons and activities.





How to create a monthly unit?



- ✓ Use a monthly grid for each month (see the handout examples)
- ✓ Circle the dates of official holidays and historical events in a yearly calendar.
- ✓ Write a list of words associated with each month and choose
 the words that may become a topic of a unit.
- ✓ The name of the unit usually related to the major topic/activity of the month and associated with science and social studies subjects.



- ✓ How would you combine subjects of morning and evening lessons so you will teach same things with different tools.



What are the main subjects for the week?



- 1. Literacy
- 2. Math
- 3. Social Studies
- 4. Science
- 5. Art

Once you have determine the subjects you start to fill in activities and lesson topics.
