October Theme: Autumn Changes & Pumpkin Experiments

Literacy: Children will be introduced to the concept of sound-symbol connections and learn letters **A & P**.

They will learn to identify images of objects that begin with letters A and P.

Math: We will learn how to compare objects by size (**big-small, tall-short**) and shape (**circle & oval**).

Furthermore, we will become skilled at symbols recognition – **0, 1, 2**, and learn concepts of **empty-full** and **heavy-light**.

Social Studies: For this month children will practice to identify **fruits & vegetables** by sorting and learn a concept **sweet-sour**. Moreover, we will discuss the topic of what is Halloween and the rules of celebrating. Children will be engaged in **pumpkin decoration** and talk about their special **costumes** for the Fall Festival.

Science: We are planning to explore **parts of a leaf and a pumpkin**. Children will make an experiment and find out why leaves changing colors during fall. They will also discover pumpkin's pulp and seeds. In addition, students will design a collage about **farm animals**.

Arts: Little scholars will be engaged in sensory activities and explore paints by hands, fingers, and sponges painting. Colors of the month are **green=yellow+blue** and **orange=red+yellow**

Reading: The students will be reinforced to take care of the classroom library, turn the pages accurately.
